29th April 2021, the college hosted online National Seminar on NABARD: Promoting Capacity Building for Rural Youth. The seminar was inaugurated with welcome address by our Principal Dr. Jitendra Aherkar. In his welcome note sir thanked NABARD for supporting the institution with financial assistance and also welcomed the chief Guest and Guest of Honour.



The Chief Guest Dr. Dilip S. Patil, Chairman, Board of Studies in Rural Development, University of Mumbai graced the seminar with his virtual presence. He stated that NABARD is playing vital role in capacity building programme and in pandemic crises also they are doing number of programmes for rural development.

The key note address was given by Dr. Vibhuti Patel, Former Professor of TISS and SNDT Women's University. She stated that the rural young adults of India are experiencing major challenges due to liberalisation and globalisation of agriculture. Integration of rural youth in Skill India, Stand up India, Start up India, Make in India, and Entrepreneurship demands proactive measures to acclimatise the rural youth with new knowledge, technologies, and management practices. Massive influx of technology under Industry 4.0 marked by artificial intelligence, machine learning, block chain technologies, robotics have benefited urban youth, mainly men. Gender responsiveness in all technology driven efforts is need of an hour. Identification of needs of the rural India and prioritising rural youth can be obtained by participatory action research and creation of activity matrix adhering to SMART-Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant and Time-bound principles. Prioritization of



action agenda and list of functions are especially important for efficient use of resources i.e., funds and functionaries. Realistic stock of funds, functions and functionaries demands that community workers are equipped with knowledge of appropriate officers and offices; procedural aspects of laws and legal system; drafting and presenting skills, making online proposals, logical arguments and peaceful negotiations, Right To Information, consistent follow up; maintaining the cohesion of the group amidst poor response; conflict resolution, exploring innovative approaches to bring the issue to public domain using social media as well as mainstream electronic and print media; expanding livelihood opportunities and social security measures and ensuring social protection, interaction with local self-government bodies, criminal justice system and governance structures.

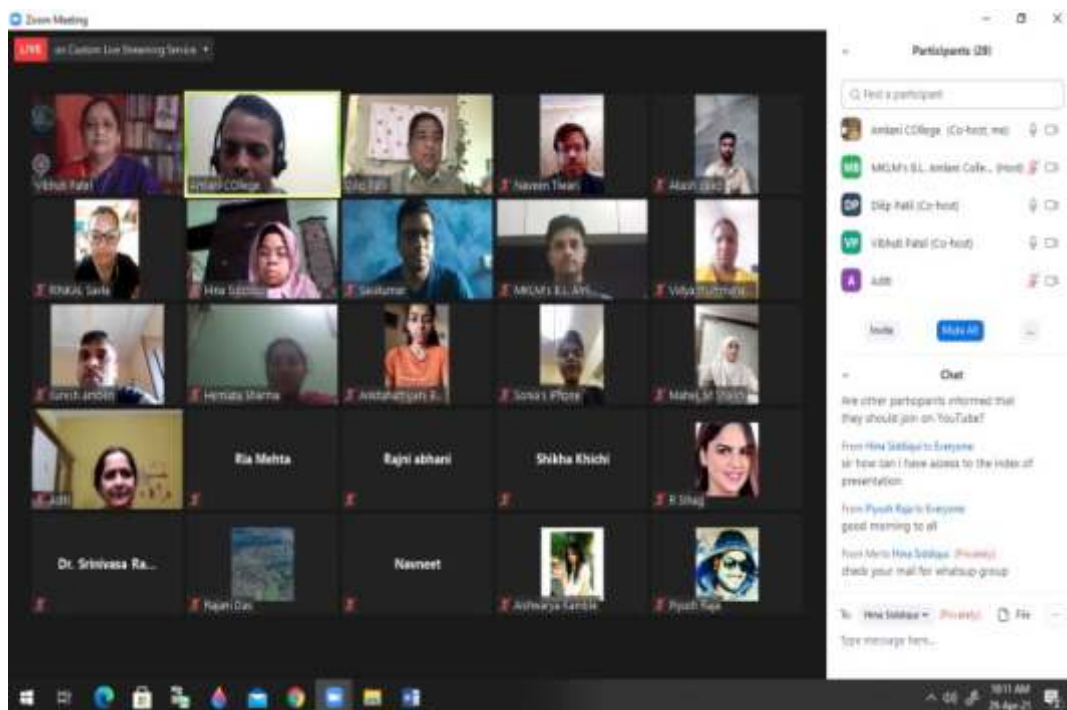
Exposure programmes and study tours of successful projects, programmes, institutions, and movements are very important for the rural youth to get the first-hand experience of best practices and limitations of different rural enterprises, cooperative societies, and federations of self-help groups, non-government organisations, civil society organisations, efforts at social solidarity, and efforts of regional-national-global networks operating in various socio-cultural and geographical locations. Rapid Rural Assessment, Identification of Needs- Practical Gender Needs & Strategic Gender Needs, Analysis of Perception of the Community, Evaluation Techniques, need to be included in the syllabi of training programmes for the rural youth. Evaluation and impact assessment of the action are particularly important to understand nuances of how, why, when and what were the reasons of success or failure and important learnings. Action-Reflection Process and Practical Praxis gains major significance can be done using models of reflections on action. Discussion and flow charts of Action, Reflection, Learning and Planning (ARLP) Model, Gibbs Reflective Cycle Model, Systematization Tool Model, Ignatian Depth Conversation Model show the ways of learning by doing.

Dr. Nilima Srivastava, Professor from Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi, presented her views on the seminar by her working paper on Capacity Building through Micro-credit Adoption of New Technology by Women in Rural Areas of Odisha.



Participants from different corners of India presented their papers on the virtual platform and highlighted the role played by NABARD in their particular state or regions. Twenty two papers were presented in the seminar.

The valedictory function was graced by Dr. Rajeshwary Rana, Deputy Director, Human Resource Development Centre, Rani Durgawati Vishwavidyaya, Madhya Pradesh, Jabalpur. 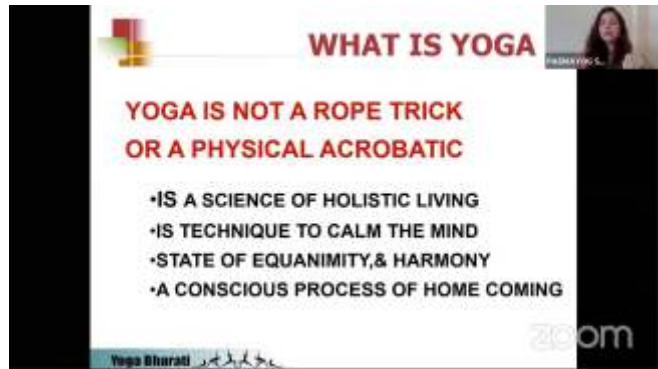

and Strengthening Resilience”

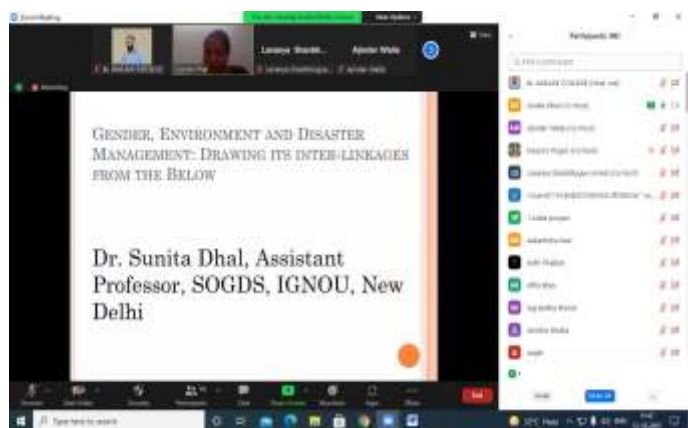

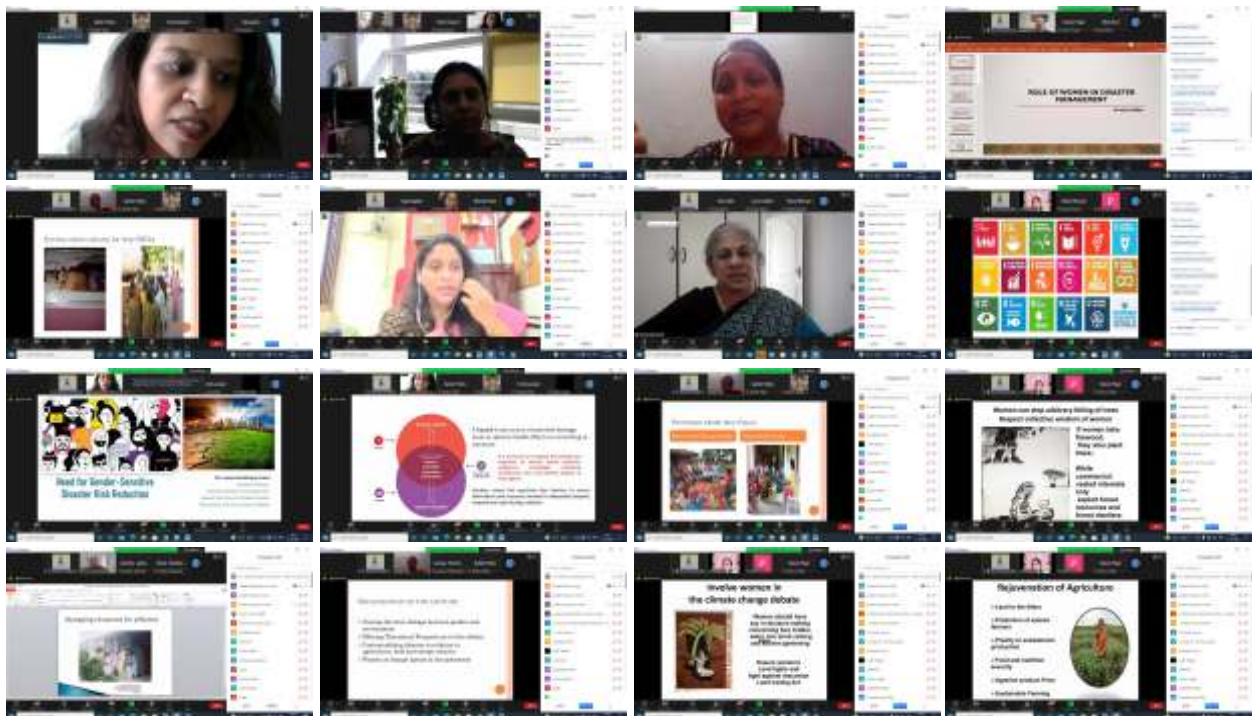

The Chief Guest the effulgent personality PSI. Punam Mirgane, Juhu Police Station, In-charge - Nirbahya Cell graced the seminar with her presence. She stated that National Human Rights Commission is playing vital role in capacity building programme and in pandemic crises also they are doing number of programmes for human rights. She also highlighted that Gender equality means a

society in where in both women and men enjoy the same opportunities, rights and obligations in different spheres of life. Equality in decision making, economic and social freedom, equal access to education and right to practice an occupation of one's choice. In order to promote gender equality, we need the empowerment of women, and concentrate on areas which are most crucial to her well being. Women's empowerment, economic, social, political, is vital to growth of any nation and to protect and nurture human rights.

The Session begin by Guest of Honour Dr. Rajeshri Varhadi Professor, Department of Law, University of Mumbai She stated about the Constitutional Provisions such as (i)freedom of speech and expression, (ii) Freedom to assemble peacefully





without arms,(iii) Freedom to form associations and unions, (iv) Freedom of movement, (v) Freedom to reside and settle in any part of India, and (vi) Freedom to practice any profession or carry on any occupation, then the concept spoken on Universal Declaration on Human Rights, 1948 International Covenants regarding Human Rights trade which exploiting due to less exploration. National Human Rights Commission is an

independent body works broadly and consists of highly knowledgeable team to work in the areas of human rights. She explained some of the unexplained scenario of vulnerability. The second session discussed on Rights of Women by enchanting speaker Dr. Kavita Lalchandani Principal, K.C Law College, Mumbai. Here she enlightened on UN Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women. The tactics to handling disappointed conditions and finding the better solution and ease way. Then the important topic brought into track Indian Constitution Provisions for Protection of Rights of Women and technique to fight against inappropriateness. She also had highlighted on various issues faced by vulnerability. Third session taken on the topic Rights of Women contd. By Dr.Hema Mehta Professor & Head, Dept. of Law, Tolani College of Commerce where she exposed about the matter of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace with related incidents as part for clear understanding & Complaints taken to investigation and the verdict of considerable one. Then the topic shifted to women trafficking which still happens but matter does not comes out, the literally force to prostitution and sometime begging, which turns to a painful life, violence against women specially the in expos able and unexplored females. Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. Female feticide and Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic. Issues relating to women of disadvantaged sections like SC/ST or persons with disability.

Forth session taken over by Rights of Women contd. Job or employment was mostly offered to men compared to females as the organization feels women are not capable for certain things and they could feel overburdened for handling many tasks.

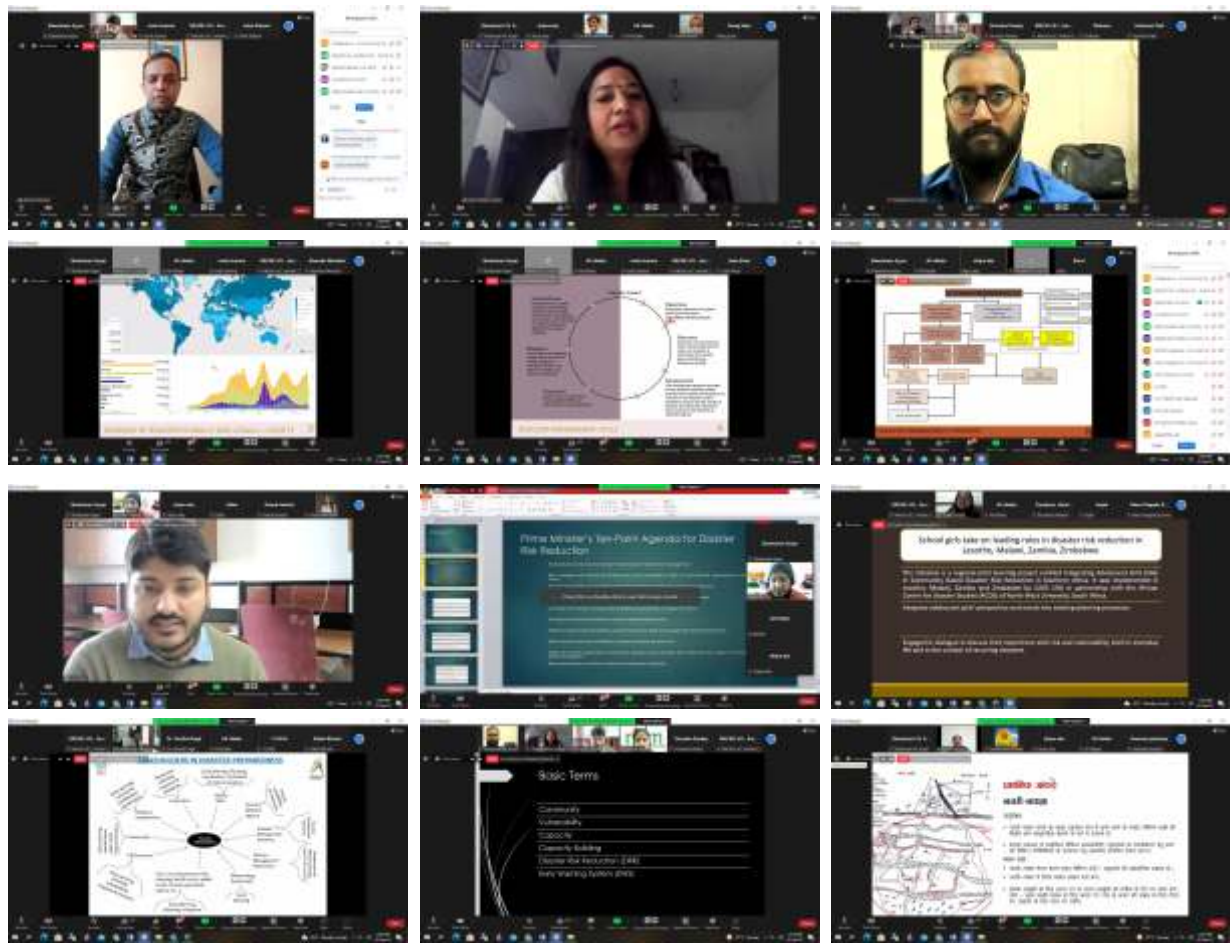
Three Days Online workshop on Based Disaster Preparedness & Management

Globally, disaster management has become an important stream in various professional and non-professional educational courses and practice. Disaster management aims at reducing or avoiding potential losses from a disaster event, assure prompt and appropriate assistance to the survivors, and achieve rapid and effective recovery. Within the disaster management cycle and concept disaster preparedness for disaster risk reduction are an essential aspect. Within the whole cycle of disaster management community is one of the most important stakeholders to adopt, imbibe and evaluate the same. Thus, the community become self-reliant, confident and empowered to deal with the disasters and similar eventualities. Disaster management is the responsibility of all stakeholders in the society including governmental/non-governmental organizations and people themselves. Imparting and disseminating the knowledge of disaster management is essential for building knowledge, attitude and skills to engage various stakeholders in managing the disaster risks. Thus, community-based disaster preparedness is most crucial in this direction.

This workshop aims at providing an understanding about community based disaster preparedness and further elaborate on various elements of disaster management and disaster preparedness with some of the basic skills required for working in the disaster management sector. The frequency and impact of disasters are on a rise from the past few decades. In the 1970s number of natural disasters recorded annually was 69 against 420 per year in 2010s (Statista, 2020) in India. Same trend follows in South Asia Region (SAR) as well, where number of disasters per year has increased sevenfold over the past few decades as per the statistics maintained by EM-DAT (EMDAT, CRED / UCLouvain, Brussels, Belgium, 2020). This has led to the situation where government, donors, and private sectors have increased their allocation for raising awareness related to disaster vulnerability and exposure as well as other risk reduction measures.

Thus, there is a need for more focused efforts on improving stakeholder's awareness and actions that reduce the vulnerabilities and increase the disaster management capacities of the communities. Minimizing the exposure of the population to disaster risks through structural mitigation activities is an integral component of CBDRR. Thus, CBDRR leads to improved disaster preparedness measures among the community and strengthening institutional structures for disaster response. The Community based Disaster Preparedness training programme provides an opportunity for field practitioners, students to learn

essential skills and knowledge in community-based disaster preparedness to address implementation challenges in a systematic manner. The participants will acquire tools and obtain knowledge on “how to” design and implement programs for reducing disaster risks and vulnerability and building community capacity. In this context, the National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM), in collaboration with M.R Nathwani College of Arts, is organizing a 3-day training programme on “Community Based Disaster Preparedness & Management” from January 31, 2022 to February 2, 2022, from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm, to build the capacity and resilience of the community in disasters.



Capacity Building & Personality Development Program

The college arranged Capacity Building & Personality Development program from 21st Feb 2022 to 23rd Feb 2022 sponsored by National Commission for Women, New Delhi. Dr. Jitendra Aherkar has inaugurated the session and welcomed all the participants and resource persons. He thanked National Commission for Women, New Delhi for support and financial assistance towards the program. Sir also gave brief introduction about the three day course on capacity building and personality development along with brief introduction about National Commission for Women. He explained the objective and history of NCW and stressed upon the importance of the program to the students.

Day 1

Topic Name - **Promoting Capacity Building Measures for Youth**

Name of the Speaker – **Prof. Priyanka Kumar**

Prof. Priyanka Kumar began her lecture by explaining learning objectives of the program. She explained what is listening i.e. it is the process of receiving, constructing meaning from and responding to spoken / non – verbal message she also spoke about types of listening. She added some thoughts on barriers to listening. She elaborated the concept of brainstorming. A brainstorming session is a tool for generating as many ideas or solutions as possible to a problem or issue. It is not a best solution to a problem or issue. She then illustrated Osborn's 4 rules of brainstorming i.e. focus on quantity, withhold criticism, encourage wild ideas, build on ideas. She then explained the concept of time management and its objectives, strategies for time management. She elucidated benefits of time management. She proceeded to stress management and explained why there is a need for stress management. She detailed about causes of stress or sources for stress. She explained briefly about different types of stress, which are mainly psychological, behavioral, and physiological. She moved to internal communication or communication at work place and its importance, its types. She explained the difference between formal communication and informal communication. She also stressed upon group discussion and do's and don'ts of group discussion to conclude her lecture.

Day 2

Topic Name - **Inculcating Professional and Career Skills**

Name of the speaker - **Prof. Dinesh Chotrani**

Prof. Dinesh Chotrani opens up his session by giving the brief introduction to career

planning, why setting a career goal is important for any individual as goal setting increases the chance of person being successful in his career. He also stresses upon how to set a career goal? Career goal is set by asking questions to oneself that what creates interest in a person?, what he likes to do? What work or occupation he would want to do for his life?, by that a person would come to know about the direction his real interest. Knowing the interest is very important in choosing right career goals. He also gave the definition of “career” by oxford English dictionary. He elucidated different steps in career planning. He then moved to the “Resume” part of his lecture in which he explained planning for resume and different parts of resume. He explained the purpose of resume with different types of resume. He mentions an important skill of writing a resume which would impress the employer. He briefly explained objectives and types of interview. He also added some tips to effectively increase the chances of clearing any interview. He distinguished between do's and don'ts in interview.

He then mentions about the presentation. How to prepare for it what are the do's and don'ts of a presentation.

Day 3

Topic Name – **Preventive Measures against Social Media Attacks**

Name of the speaker – **Prof. Sonali Chikhalikar**

Prof. Sonali Chikhalikar began her lecture by stressing on importance of being digital citizens as it enables us to transform information into knowledge. She explained the concept of digital literacy. She taught how to create a Gmail ID? And how to use it? She gave Tips for Email safety she elucidated Banking services and payment Gateways I.e. Debit Card and how to use it, credit card and how to use it. She explained how to use Paytm. Also, she gave details about Google pay UPI Payment method, BHIM Pay App. She gave brief knowledge about protection of own accounts on social media, why it is important to do so. It protects account from being hacked by hackers. She concluded her lecture by explaining dark web and profile hacking.

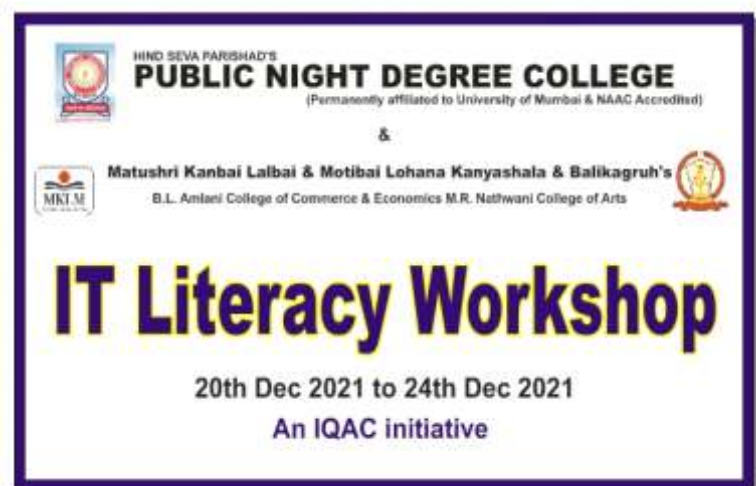
National Webinar on “Time and Stress Management at Workplace”

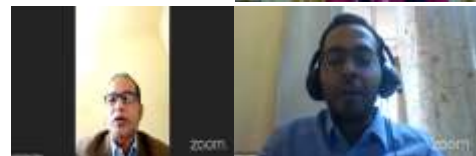
the webinar was to create awareness among the participants to understand the digital world which going to be very common in upcoming day. The workshop conducted for around four days to explain the phenomena in detail.

Green Mumbai Clean Mumbai

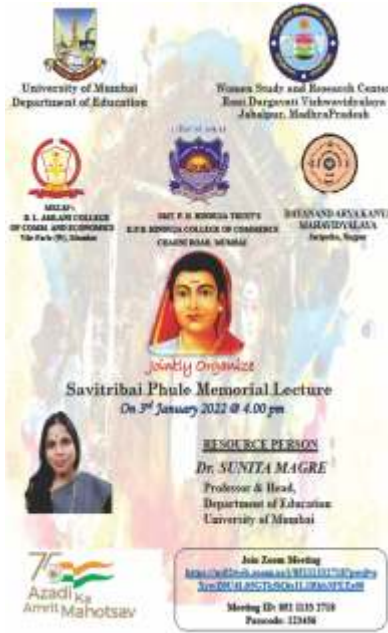

SDP on “Professional Ethics”



Dr. Francis Vaidya began her lecture by introducing the concept of “ethics”. She then elaborated the interconnection between values, morality and ethics by giving suitable examples. She then moved to the philosophy on ethics. She explained the scope and basic principles of ethics. There are seven basic principles of ethics. She moved towards the main topic of the program i.e., Professional Ethics. She defines the concept of professional ethics. Later she introduced the concept by explaining all the factors and principles which are there under professional ethics. There are Principles that guide the actions and decisions of professionals, and determine if they are Moral or Immoral, or right or wrong, or rational or irrational, or just or unjust. It is Professional capability for securing social, technical and professional legitimacy of decisions and actions. She then explained various characteristics of professional ethics. To conclude her lecture, she explained the verities of ethical profession by giving few examples like four component model by James rest and person situation interactionism model by Linda Trevino.

An Awareness Program on Women Constitutional Rights

Prof. Priyanka Arora Kumar began her lecture by giving brief introduction about need of the awareness program on Women Constitutional Rights in country like India. She mentions the need of positive discrimination in favour of women in India. Coming up to the main content of the program she started briefing few of the constitutional privileges like "Equality before law for women (Article 14)", The State not to discriminate against any citizen on grounds of religion, race, caste, sex, place of birth or any of them (Article 15 (1)) and The State to make any special provision in favour of women and children (Article 15 (3)) etc. She spoke the crimes, which are directed specifically against women, are characterized as 'Crime against Women'. She said in order to protect women against crime state has enacted various laws. These laws are not gender specific, the provisions of law affecting women significantly have been reviewed periodically and amendments carried out to keep pace with the emerging requirements. She concluded her lecture by giving in detail examples of acts which have special provisions to safeguard women. Some of the examples of acts she mentioned are The Hindu Marriage Act 1955, The Plantation Labour Act, 1951 and The Family Courts Act, 1954 etc.



Awareness Program on Code of Conduct



Prof. Rohit Kashinath Pithale began his lecture presentation by stating the definition of code of conduct. He said A code of conduct is the most common policy within an organization and This policy lays out the company's principles, standards, and the moral and ethical expectations that employees and third parties are held to as they interact with the organization. Then he explained how code of conduct is an integral part of

compliance efforts, as it provides documentation that an employee or third party has violated company policy if illegal activity arises. Then he moved to the importance of code of conduct. He mentioned that a code of conduct serves as a reference point for employees to make better choices on a day-to-day basis. To conclude his lecture, he finally explained what an effective code of conduct in an organization is. An effective code of conduct of an organization must include few things like, First, they should be regularly reviewed. The code should be a living, breathing document that is highly relevant to employees and their work and finally, an effective code of conduct is digestible by the audience it is intended for. It should not be overloaded with legal speak that only the lawyers at the company can understand but instead written in an uncomplicated format that is easy for all to comprehend.
