Ashadi Ekadashi Celebration

The most significant Ekadasi vrata commemorated as the first Ekadashi is Ashadi Ekadasi, often spelled Ashadhi Ekadashi. It occurs on the eleventh day of Ashad Maas's brilliant half. Ashadhi Ekadashi, which is observed between the months of June and July (Aashaadh Shukla paksha), is more of a religious procession event. Every month's two "Ekadashi" days, or eleventh days, are revered as being especially significant. However, the big Ekadashi or Mahaekadashi is celebrated on the eleventh day (bright) of Ashadh. Because Vishnu sleeps on this Mahaekadashi and awakens on Prabodhini Ekadashi in the Kartik month, this Mahaekadashi is also known as Shayani Ekadashi. The rainy season falls at this time, which is referred to as Chaturmas. We observed Ashadhi Ekadashi Festival at our college on 3rd July, 2023. Dr. Jitendra Aherkar, presented a moving opening to the event and a succinct overview of the day's historical significance. He explains the reasons why people celebrate this specific holiday.

Along with the students, all of the professors and staff actively participated in the celebration. Students participated in a lezim dance performance. Girls performed foogdi on college campuses with enthusiasm and delight. A Palkhi yatra is also part of the festival. On the occasion of this event, the Varkari Sect holds Pandharpur wari in Maharashtra.





Wari or Pandharpur Wari is a pilgrimage to Pandharpur, Maharashtra, to pay tribute to Vithoba. It entails transporting a saint's paduka in a palkhi from their individual shrines to Pandharpur, most notably for Dnyaneshwar and Tukaram. In this procession, many pilgrims are on foot.

The Marathi word for "one who performs the wari" is "warkari." The custom dates back more than 700–800 years. Many students at our college expressed thanks for the profound instruction they had received under the direction of professors on Guru-Purnima. When students honor the lessons life has taught them, every day may be Guru Purnima, according to our principal Dr. Jitendra Aherkar. Each of us possesses wisdom, but we must shine a light on it.

Certification Course on Indian Knowledge System

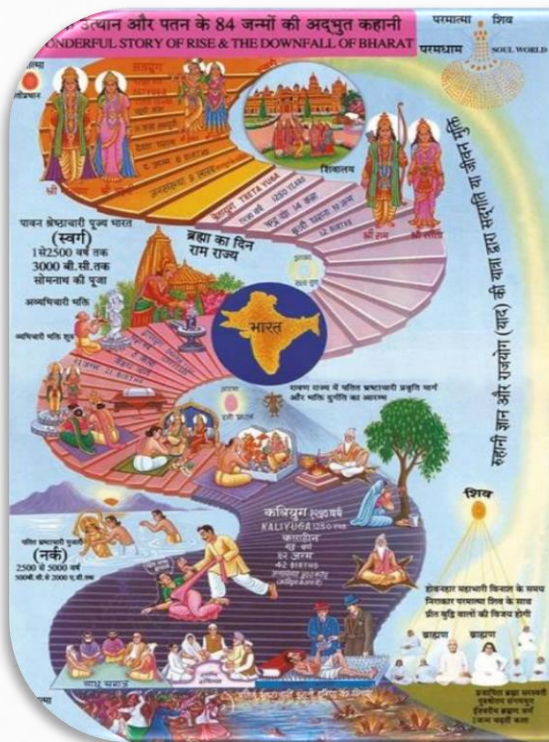

Suicide Prevention Workshop

Ms. Diya, a volunteer from the Sisters Living Works Foundation delivered a comprehensive presentation on the complexities of suicide. The presentation began with an overview of suicide statistics to emphasize the prevalence of the issue. She also explained common risk factors associated with suicide. Then the students were taught how to identify warning signs that may indicate suicidal ideation and how to empathetically address them. The participants were also given information about some basic intervention strategies that are of importance when handling such delicate issues. At the end of the presentation, Ms. Diya shared information about available mental health resources and crisis helplines that could be beneficial to someone who might be in need of assistance. The workshop featured an interactive Q&A session after the presentation where participants had the opportunity to ask questions and seek clarification on the topics discussed. Participants asked many questions to the volunteers related to mental health, suicide prevention and the foundation's work. In the Q&A session some participants also shared personal experiences and insights related to suicide prevention. The workshop was an informative and knowledge rich event, which successfully raised awareness about suicide prevention in participants, equipping participants with essential knowledge and skills, and fostering a sense of community support.



Suicide Prevention Workshop



On 1st September 2023, the Department of Psychology organized a workshop to commemorate Suicide Prevention Day in collaboration with the Sisters Living Works Foundation. The SLW foundation is an NGO that works for suicide prevention primarily for women. The World Suicide Prevention Day is observed every year on 10th September to raise awareness about this mental health crisis. The 1.5 hour workshop aimed to raise awareness about suicide prevention, provide information on identifying warning signs, and equip participants with strategies to offer support to individuals who may be at risk of suicide.

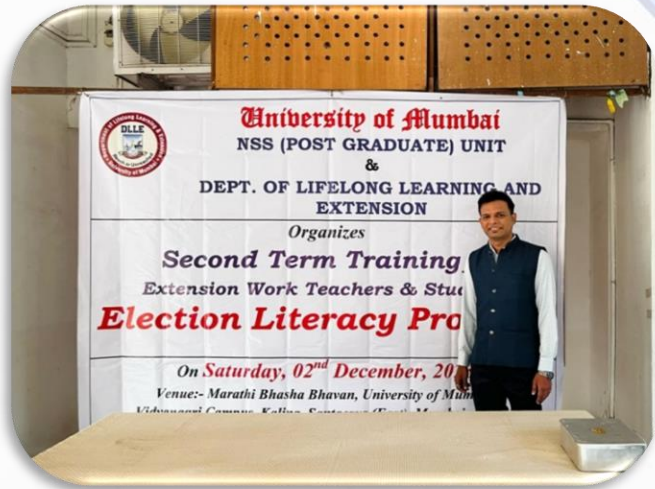
Integrated Personality Development Course (IPDC) Short Term Course

Sustainable Development Goals: Transforming Vision

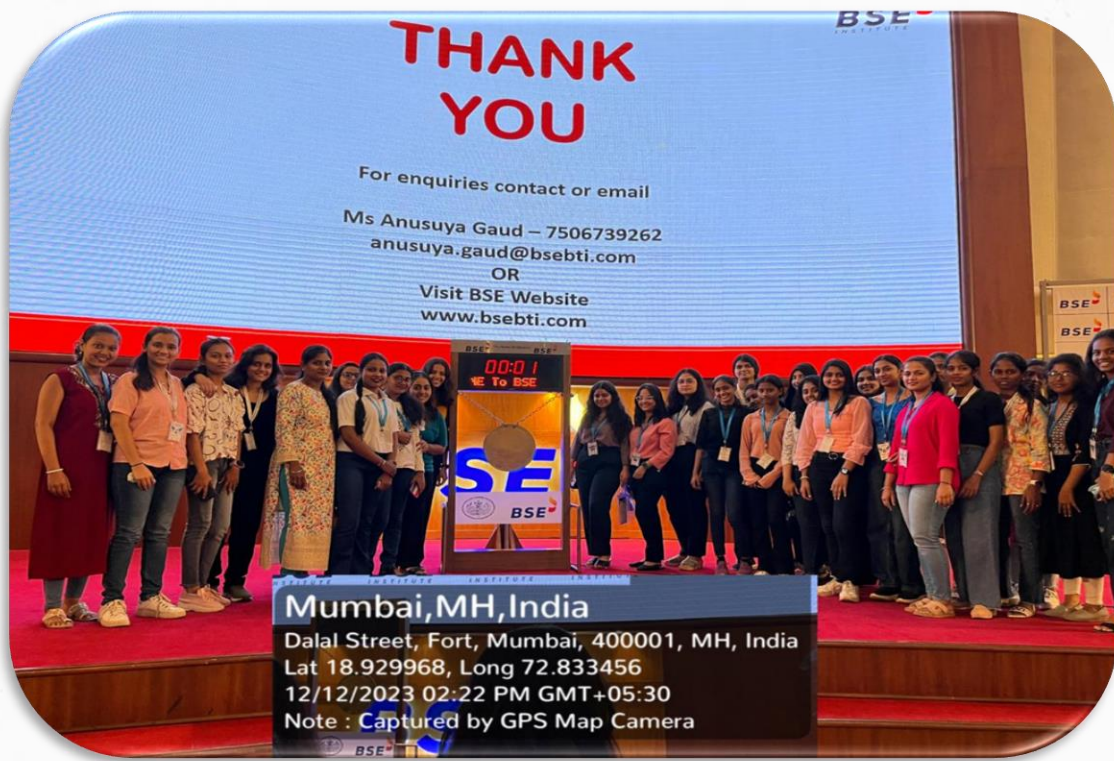

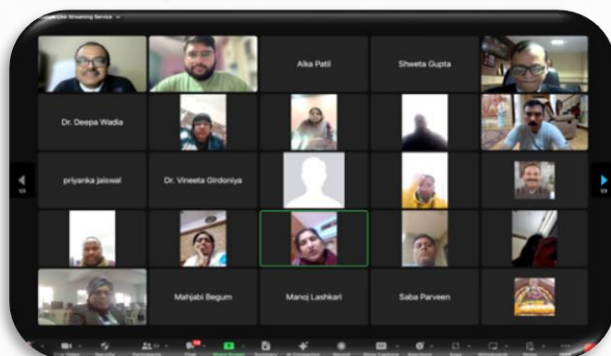
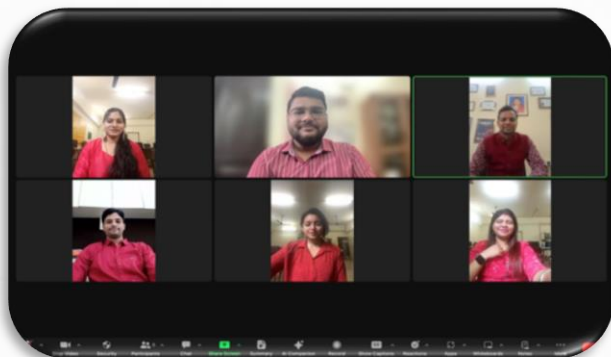


Traditional Day Celebration

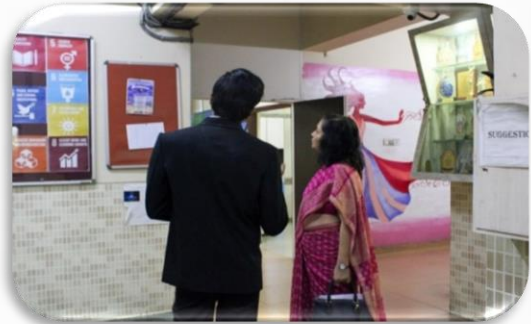


Celebration of International Women's Day
