



## Students Grievances Redressal Committee

A Students Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) is a committee that listens to and resolves student grievances. The committee's goal is to provide a way for students to voice their concerns and receive a fair and impartial resolution.

How does the SGRC work.

- Students can submit grievances online or in person
- The committee reviews the grievances and determines their merit
- The committee takes action based on the severity of the grievance
- The committee may forward the grievance to the relevant department for further action
- The committee may meet periodically to discuss the status of grievances
- The committee may follow up with students at regular intervals until the grievance is resolved.

Objectives of the SGRC.

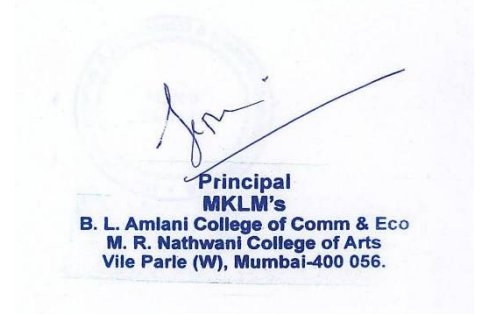
- The SGRC helps students feel comfortable expressing their concerns without fear of victimization
